CITY OF HURSTBOURNE ACRES, KENTUCKY ORDINANCE NO. ______, SERIES 2000

WHEREAS, the City of HURSTBOURNE ACRES, has found it to be a hazard to allow parking to continue on Wesley between the intersection of Wesley and Bristol and between Blowing Tree and Wesley, and

WHEREAS, the City Commission deems that it is in the best interest of the citizens to prohibit parking on Wesley between the intersection of Wesley and Bristol and between Blowing Tree and Wesley in the City,

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF HURSTBOURNE ACRES:

<u>Section 1</u>. It shall be unlawful, at all times, to park any vehicle on Wesley between the intersection of Wesley and Bristol and between Blowing Tree and Wesley within the City of Hurstbourne Acres, Kentucky.

Section 2. Any violation of this ordinance shall subject the owner of the vehicle to fine of not less than \$50.00 nor more than \$50.00, and towing expenses. Towing and impoundment fees to be paid by the violator. Each occurrence will be viewed as a separate offense for which separate fines may be levied. The state registration of ownership of the offending vehicle shall be prima facie evidence of ownership of the vehicle.

Section 3. Any violation of this ordinance shall subject the violator to a civil penalty in an amount equal to the minimum fine prescribed by Section 2 of this ordinance. Such civil penalty may be recovered by the city in a civil action in the nature of a debt if the offender does not pay the penalty within twenty (20) days after the offender has been cited for the ordinance violation.
