

**CITY OF HURSTBOURNE ACRES, KENTUCKY
ORDINANCE NO. 2, SERIES 2001**

WHEREAS, the City of Hurstbourne Acres has found it to be a hazard to allow parking to continue at the intersections of the City of Hurstbourne Acres; has found it to be an non-aesthetic nuisance to allow parking of commercial vehicles at private residences and,

WHEREAS, the City Commission deems that it is in the best interest of the citizens to place controls on parking within the City of Hurstbourne Acres.

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF HURSTBOURNE ACRES that Ordinance #2, Series 2000, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1: It shall be unlawful at all times, to park any vehicle within ___ feet of any intersection; within four (4) feet of a private driveway, or within ten (10) feet of a fire hydrant, within the City of Hurstbourne Acres, Kentucky.

Section 2: It shall be unlawful at all times, to park commercial vehicles at the private homes of individuals who run small businesses out of their homes.

Section 3: Any violation of this Ordinance shall subject the owner of the vehicle to a fine of not less than \$50.00 nor more than \$500.00, and towing expenses. Towing and impoundment fees to be paid by the violator. Each occurrence shall be viewed as a separate offense for which separate fines may be levied. The state registration of ownership of the offending vehicle shall be prima facie evidence of ownership of the vehicle.


Section 4: Any violation of this Ordinance shall subject the violator to a civil penalty in an amount equal to the minimum fine prescribed by Section 3 of this Ordinance. Such civil penalty may be recovered by the city in the civil action in the nature of a debt if the offender does not pay the penalty within twenty (20) days after the offender has been cited for the ordinance violation.

Section 5: All Ordinances in conflict with this Order are hereby repealed.
