

**ORDINANCE NO.   4  , SERIES 2009  
CITY OF HURSTBOURNE ACRES, KENTUCKY**

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING USE OF CITY PARK PROPERTY

**WHEREAS**, it is the responsibility of the City Commission to pass ordinances and regulations as a matter of public necessity, public welfare and public interest, and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Commissioners of the City of Hurstbourne Acres, Kentucky, have the authority pursuant to statute to enact Ordinances relating to the City so as to protect the health and safety of its citizens, and

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission has determined that an Ordinance regulating the use of City Park property does serve this public interest,

**THEREFORE, BE IT NOW ORDAINED THAT:**

Section 1. The City Park property shall be open to the public from dawn to dusk. The City Park property shall be closed to the public from dusk to dawn.

Section 2. Any person who is found within the boundaries of City Park property of the City of Hurstbourne Acres, Kentucky, in violation of Section 1 of this Ordinance may be cited for criminal trespassing.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication according to law, and summary publication is authorized.



City of Hurstbourne Acres

The Ad VALORUM Rate  
On all real and Personal Property

Whereas, the Mayor and the Commission of the City of Hurstbourne Acres, Kentucky, have the authority pursuant to enact Ordinances relating to the City and

Whereas, it is required that the Ad VOLARUM rate be established and levied for the year July 1, 2009 though June 30, 2010, on all real and personal property, for the general operating purposes of the City to cover fiscal year July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010.

**BE IT ORDAINED THAT**

Section 1. January 1, 2009 is hereby set as the assessment date for all real and personal property subject to city taxation within the boundaries of the City of Hurstbourne Acres, Kentucky.

Section 2. The City Clerk and Treasurer are directed to obtain a true copy of the assessment of property within the corporate limits of the City of Hurstbourne Acres, Kentucky and to make out tax bills and mail same. Each tax bill shall show the property and improvements thereon separately, the name of the supposed owners and the ad volarum rate and the tax due for the fiscal year.

Section 3. Upon delivery of such bills, the Treasurer shall have the responsibility of supervising the collection of same, and all the remittances shall be made to the City Treasurer, as required by law. Collection of Delinquent Taxes shall be made in the manner prescribed by law.

Section 4. The Ad Valorum rate for this year is fixed at \$ .14 \_\_per One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) valuation of property assessed for taxation. Such taxes shall be due as follows:

Discount of 1% if paid on or before July 31, 2009

Net Bill if paid during August and September 2009

Penalty if paid during October 2009-5% (Five per cent)

Penalty if paid during November 2009 6% (Six percent)

After November 30, 2009-6% penalty plus 1% interest per month until paid. Penalties are cumulative. If a suit is initiated, then the taxpayer shall pay court cost and reasonable attorney fees.

Section 5. The tax payment shall be made as follows:



Section 6. The proceeds of this tax are to be used as follows: \$.14 \_per One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) of valuation, being the entire amount of said tax, plus interest on penalties collected thereon, for the general operation of the City.

This Ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and publication.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF HURSTBOURNE ACRES, KENTUCKY:


Section 1: That the annual budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2009 and ending June 30, 2010 is hereby adopted:


