**AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO COMPENSATION OF ELECTED CITY
OFFICIALS AND CLASSIFICATION AND COMPENSATION OF CITY
EMPLOYEES**

WHEREAS the City Commission of the City of Hurstbourne Acres, Kentucky, has the authority pursuant to statute to enact Ordinances relating to the City, and;

WHEREAS the City Commission deems it necessary to establish the compensation of elected City officials and the classification and compensation of City employees;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF HURSTBOURNE ACRES, KENTUCKY, THAT:

SECTION 1. COMPENSATION OF ELECTED CITY OFFICIALS:

The Mayor and City Commissioners are compensated as follows:

Mayor - \$7,560.00 per annum

City Commissioners - \$4,200.00 per annum

SECTION 2. CLASSIFICATION AND COMPENSATION OF CITY EMPLOYEES

The following is a list of City employee classifications and compensation for each classification:

1. City Clerk: Directs operations of City Clerk's office; Clerk of governing body and custodian of records; performs other duties as assigned by the Mayor and Commission.

Annual Compensation: \$4,410.00

2. City Treasurer: Responsible for the financial accounts of the City; manages budget and cash flow issues; performs other duties as assigned by the Mayor and Commission.

Annual Compensation: \$8,400.00

3. Chief of Police: Directs all functions and operations of the Police Department in an efficient

and effective manner to ensure its objectives of preservation of the peace and the protection of life and property; performs administrative and managerial police work of considerable difficulty at the upper management level; promotes the interests of the Department as a liason to the Mayor and Commission and through contact with community organizations.

Annual Compensation: \$58,600.00 (Base Salary - \$52,500.00; KLEFPF - \$3,100.00, and ; Insurance Costs - \$3,000.00).

4. Police Officer(s): Assists the Chief of Police in all phases of the administration of the Police Department; applies Department policy, procedures, goals and objectives; promotes the interests of the Department through contact with community organizations and citizens; performs other related duties as required.

Compensation: \$21.00/hour (part time position).

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is effective immediately and shall be published as is required by law.
